

FINANCIAL REPORT YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2019

Mr President and Members

It is my pleasure to present the Treasurer's Report for the previous financial year.

Attached is the audited Financial Statement, comprising the Balance Sheet and the Income and Expenditure Account, for the period 1 July 2018 to 30 June 2019.

The Society is registered for GST. This registration includes each of the State chapters, and the Society submits quarterly business activity statements. The Society also has tax free status under an interpretation of ATO rulings, relating to Australian industry promotion.

Currently EESA is incorporated in NSW, under NSW Fair Trading legislation.

The National account deficit for the year was \$45,873, compared to last year's deficit of \$15,543. Income from subscriptions increased, whilst interest from cash and term deposits decreased.

The State Chapter accounts have again been included in the audit process. Balance Sheets and Income and Expenditure Statements for each Chapter, and a combined summary sheet for the Chapter accounts, are included.

An analysis combining all accounts, showing external income to all accounts and payments of external expenses (so excluding inter-organisation transfers such as chapter support for student awards and member subscription proportion) indicates a Society income of \$186,412, expenses of \$195,316, and an overall deficit of \$8,904. Total Society assets were \$592,825.

The overall financial position of the Society remains very healthy.

I wish to propose that:

- 1. the attached Accounts to 30 June 2019 be adopted
- 2. Nina Dillon of Goulburn, be re-appointed as Auditor for the forthcoming year 2019 / 2020.

NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE ACCOUNTS

Note 1. Statement of Accounting Principles

The Society accounts on a cash basis of accounting rather than the accrual basis.

The entity is not a reporting entity because in the member's opinion there are unlikely to exist users who are unable to command the preparation of reports tailored so as to satisfy specially all of their information needs, and these accounts are therefore "Special Purpose Financial Reports"

The entity has applied the Reporting Entity concept and in the opinion of the members no Accounting Standards have mandatory applicability.

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the historical cost convention. The accounting policies adopted are consistent with those of the previous year except as otherwise stated.

Because of the legal standing of the member's subscriptions, no accrual of outstanding amounts is made.
